Cefndir yr Ysgol / *The School's Background*

Ysgol gynradd **cyfrwng Cymraeg** a gynhelir gan Gyngor Bwrdeistref Sirol Caerffili yw Ysgol

Gymraeg Penalltau, sy'n darparu ar gyfer addysg merched a bechgyn rhwng 3 ac 11 oed. Agorwyd yr ysgol ym mis Medi 2009 mewn ymateb i'r galw cynyddol am addysg cyfrwng Cymraeg yng Nghymru. y sir. Ni yw'r 11eg ysgol gynradd Gymraeg i agor yng Nghaerffili. Mae'r ysgol fodern, bwrpasol hon wedi'i lleoli ar ystâd dai Redrow, Cwm Calon, ger Ystrad Mynach. Mae'r disgyblion yn mwynhau ac yn profi addysg gyfrwng Cymraeg a chyfoeth o brofiadau cyffrous. Ein amcanion yw:

- Meithrin parch ac angerdd at y Gymraeg a hybu a datblygu gallu disgyblion i fynegi eu hunain yn hyderus ac yn rhugl yn y Gymraeg a'r Saesneg. Anogir disgyblion i ddangos balchder a pharch tuag at yr iaith Gymraeg, treftadaeth a diwylliant Cymru ac i drin ieithoedd a diwylliannau eraill gyda pharch cyfartal.
- Darparu amgylchedd diogel, hapus a gofalgar i ddisgyblion a staff.
- Creu cyfleoedd dysgu sy'n cymell, ennyn diddordeb a herio dysgwyr.
- Rhoi cyfle i bob disgybl ddatblygu i'w lawn botensial ym mhob agwedd o'r cwricwlwm.
- Annog pob plentyn i fod yn annibynnol, creadigol a chwilfrydig trwy ddatblygu eu sgiliau meddwl: y gallu i brosesu gwybodaeth, rhesymu, ymholi a gwerthuso.
- Trin pob disgybl yn deg, gan gynnig cyfleoedd cyfartal i bob disgybl, waeth beth yw eu gallu, rhyw, crefydd neu hil.
- Annog parch, cyfrifoldeb a gonestrwydd a meithrin pwysigrwydd ymddygiad da a chwarteisi ym mhob disgybl.
- Anogir disgyblion i ddangos balchder a pharch tuag at yr iaith Gymraeg, treftadaeth a diwylliant Cymru ac i drin ieithoedd a diwylliannau eraill gyda pharch cyfartal.

Ysgol Gymraeg Penalltau is a **Welsh medium** primary school maintained by Caerphilly County Borough Council, catering for the education of girls and boys between the ages of 3 to 11. The school was opened in September 2009 in response to the increasing demand for Welsh medium education in the county. We are the 11th Welsh primary school to open in Caerphilly. This modern, purpose-built school is located on the Redrow housing estate, Cwm Calon, near Ystrad Mynach. All pupils enjoy and experience Welsh medium education and a wealth of exciting experiences. Our aims are:

- To nurture respect and passion for the Welsh language and promote and develop pupils' ability to express themselves confidently and fluently in both Welsh and English. Pupils are encouraged to demonstrate pride and respect for the Welsh language, heritage and culture and to treat other languages and cultures with equal respect.
- To provide a safe, happy and caring environment for pupils and staff.
- To create learning opportunities which motivate, engage and challenge learners.
- To give every pupil the opportunity to develop to their full potential in all aspects of the curriculum.
- To encourage every child to be independent, creative and curious by developing their thinking skills: the ability to process information, reason, enquire and evaluate.
- To treat all pupils fairly, offering every pupil an equal opportunity, regardless of ability, gender, religion or race.
- To encourage respect, responsibility and honesty and instil in each pupil the importance of good behaviour and courtesy.
- Pupils are encouraged to demonstrate pride and respect for the Welsh language, heritage and culture and to treat other languages and cultures with equal respect.
