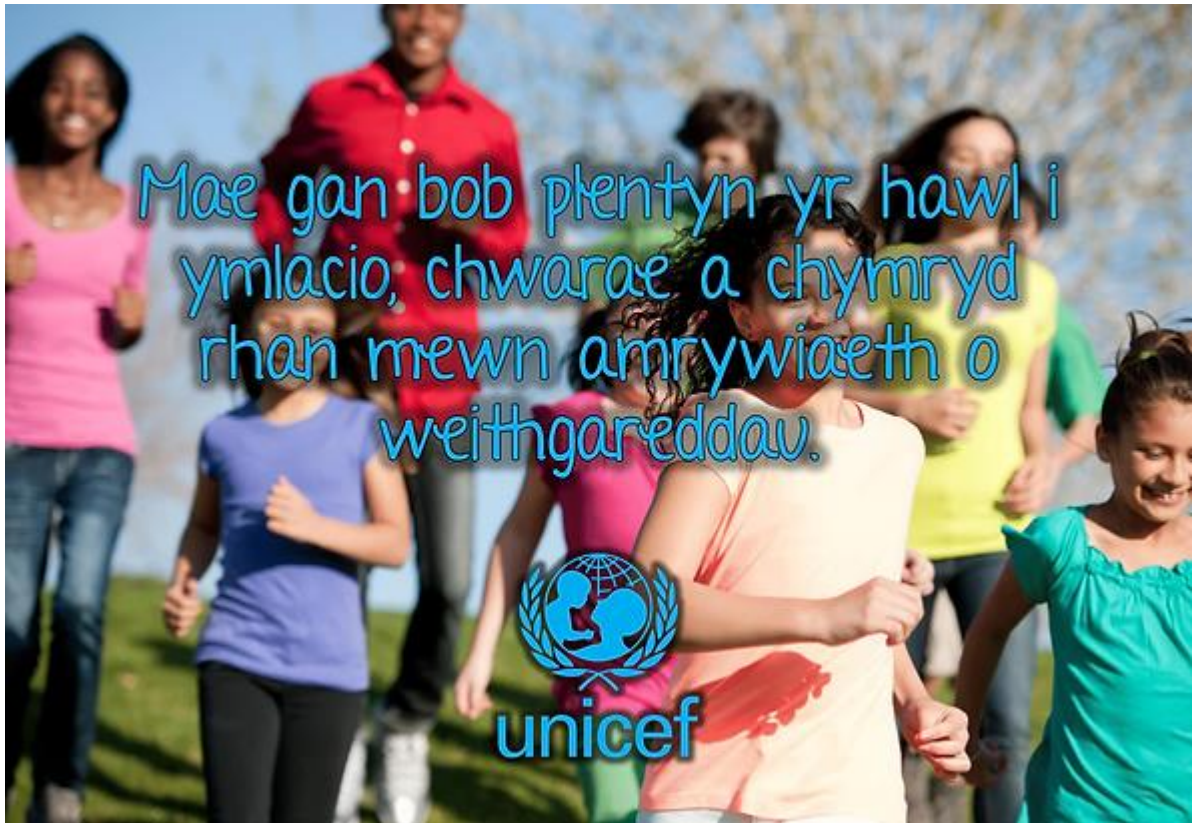

This week, as part of our assemblies and discussions, we are focusing on Article 31 of the UNICEF's Children's Right Charter which says that children and young people have the right to have fun in the way they want to, whether by playing sports, watching films, or doing something else entirely. They have the right to rest, too. Children and young people should be able to take part freely in cultural activities, just like adults. Now, does this mean they don't have to do chores?! Absolutely not! We are discussing balance of leisure and responsibilities as part of our discussions this week. One of the most important ways that children can play is by turning off digital devices and getting out in the outdoors. It's a well-known yet sad fact that children in the UK, on the whole, spend less time outdoors than people in prison. At Ysgol Penalltau, we want to champion the fact that play is not just as important as learning but that it is essential to developing as rounded individuals.
