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Children have the right to give their opinions freely on issues that affect them.

Adults should listen and take children seriously.

RESPECT FOR CHILDREN'S VIEWS

This week, we are focusing on **Article 12** of the UNICEF Children's Rights Charter. This article highlights that children have the right to share their thoughts and opinions on matters that affect them—and importantly, to have those views listened to and respected.

At Ysgol Penalltau, we believe that every child's voice matters. Whether it's decisions about learning, play, or school life, we are encouraging pupils to speak up and share their ideas. Through class discussions, school councils, and pupil voice activities, we're helping children understand that their opinions can help shape their environment and make a difference.

Listening to children isn't just about being polite—it's about recognising their right to be heard and valued.
